AN ACT relating to real property; requiring the Real Estate Division of the Department of Business and Industry to keep confidential certain records and information obtained by the Division in regulating the sale of subdivided land; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

1 Existing law authorizes the Real Estate Division of the Department of Business  
2 and Industry, under certain circumstances, to keep confidential the criminal and  
3 financial records obtained by the Division pursuant to chapter 645 of NRS  
4 concerning a real estate salesman or other person licensed pursuant to that chapter,  
5 an applicant for such a license or an owner-developer. (NRS 645.180) **Section 1** of  
6 this bill requires the Division, under certain circumstances, to keep confidential the  
7 criminal records, financial records and social security number of each applicant for  
8 a license or permit issued pursuant to chapter 119 of NRS which governs the sale of  
9 subdivided land, and each person who holds such a license or permit. **Section 2** of  
10 this bill allows such records and information to be shared with certain other  
11 governmental agencies but not with the public.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1      **Section 1.** Chapter 119 of NRS is hereby amended by adding  
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3      *Except as otherwise provided in subsection 1 of NRS 119.265,  
4 unless otherwise ordered by a court, the Division shall keep  
5 confidential:*

6      *1. The criminal and financial records of a licensee, permittee  
7 or an applicant for a license or permit issued pursuant to this  
8 chapter; and*

9      *2. The social security number of a licensee, permittee or an  
10 applicant for a license or permit issued pursuant to this chapter.*

11     **Sec. 2.** NRS 119.265 is hereby amended to read as follows:

12     119.265 1. Except as otherwise provided in this section and  
13 NRS 239.0115, a complaint filed with the Division alleging a  
14 violation of this chapter, all documents and other information filed  
15 with the complaint and all documents and other information  
16 compiled as a result of an investigation conducted to determine  
17 whether to initiate disciplinary action are confidential and may be  
18 disclosed in whole or in part only as necessary in the course of  
19 administering this chapter or to a licensing board or agency or any  
20 other governmental agency, including, without limitation, a law  
21 enforcement agency, that is investigating a person who holds a  
22 license or permit issued pursuant to this chapter.

23     2. ~~[The]~~ *Except as otherwise provided in section 1 of this act,  
24 the* complaint or other charging documents filed with the Division  
25 to initiate disciplinary action and all documents and other  
26 information considered by the Division or a hearing officer when  
27 determining whether to impose discipline are public records.

28     **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
