ASSEMBLY CONCURRENT RESOLUTION—Designating  
March 31, 2009, to honor the Kerak Shrine Temple and  
the Zelzah Shrine Temple.

1 WHEREAS, What was to become the Ancient Arabic Order of  
2 the Nobles of the Mystic Shrine for North America, an international  
3 fraternity based on fun, fellowship and the Masonic principles of  
4 brotherly love, relief and truth, was formed in New York City in  
5 1872 and now has approximately 400,000 Shriners who are  
6 members of 191 temples throughout the United States, Canada,  
7 Mexico and the Republic of Panama; and

1        WHEREAS, While many associate the Shriners with the guys in  
2 parades wearing wild costumes who drive funny little cars or with a  
3 circuses, clowns and, their distinctive symbol, the red fez with a  
4 black tassel, they are better known as the “World’s Greatest  
5 Fraternity” that is responsible for funding and operating the  
6 “World’s Greatest Philanthropy,” the Shriners Hospitals for  
7 Children; and

8        WHEREAS, While formed primarily as a social organization, the  
9 Shriners, always involved in philanthropic work, wanted to do more  
10 for humanity, leading to the opening of 22 Shriners Hospitals for  
11 Children, often called the “heart and soul of the Shrine”; and

12        WHEREAS, Since 1922, Shriners Hospitals have helped  
13 approximately 865,000 children, at no charge to the families,  
14 regardless of financial need, and have a three-fold mission of expert  
15 treatment, cutting-edge research and outstanding teaching programs;  
16 and

17        WHEREAS, More than 8,000 physicians have received training at  
18 Shriners Hospitals over the past 20 years, and since beginning a  
19 formal research program more than 40 years ago, more than \$515  
20 million has been invested in research projects; and

21        WHEREAS, Children with orthopedic conditions, severe burns,  
22 spinal cord injuries, and cleft lip and palate are eligible for medical  
23 treatment and, in addition, receive psychosocial, nutritional and  
24 recreational care; and

25        WHEREAS, The Shriners Hospitals are supported by a \$5 annual  
26 assessment from each Shriner, contributions, bequests and various  
27 fundraisers, one of the largest of which is the annual Shrine Circus,  
28 first performed in Detroit, Michigan, in 1906; and

29        WHEREAS, Fundraisers for the Kerak Shrine Temple, the  
30 Northern Nevada chapter, include such annual events as the Capitol  
31 Shrine Bowl in Sacramento, California, which funds the  
32 transportation of children to out-of-state Shriners Hospitals, and  
33 the Kerak Shrine Circus, in which some of the Shriners perform as  
34 the Kerak Klowns; and

35        WHEREAS, Fundraisers for the Zelzah Shrine Temple, the  
36 Southern Nevada chapter, include such annual events as the Justin  
37 Timberlake Shriners Hospitals for Children Open, the “Lance  
38 Burton & Friends” benefit and the Vidalia onion sale; now,  
39 therefore, be it

40        RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, THE  
41 SENATE CONCURRING, That March 31, 2009, is hereby designated  
42 to honor the Kerak Shrine Temple and the Zelzah Shrine Temple for  
43 their philanthropic work and dedication to the children of Nevada;
