ASSEMBLY CONCURRENT RESOLUTION—Memorializing native Nevadan and public servant David H. Fulstone II.

- 1 WHEREAS, David H. “Davey” Fulstone II, whose Lyon County
- 2 family roots can be traced back to the 1800s, was born in Yerington
- 3 on December 23, 1950, to David and Angelina Fulstone and lived in
- 4 Yerington for his entire life; and
- 5 WHEREAS, This native Nevadan spent over 40 years farming
- 6 with his father and was a staunch activist for agricultural issues and
- 7 matters related to the Walker River as he kept abreast of current
- 8 issues and tried to preserve the local heritage and way of life; and



1 WHEREAS, On September 10, 1977, David married his beloved
2 wife Diane Reynolds, whose lifelong support, including
3 accompanying him to Israel to study water conservation techniques
4 and different methods of farming, was invaluable in every aspect of
5 his life; and

6 WHEREAS, Because of his devotion to issues that were important
7 to Mason Valley, this mentor and leader was actively involved in
8 public service, serving on the Lyon County Board of
9 Commissioners for 8 years, on the National Commission on
10 Agricultural Finance as an appointee of President Reagan, on the
11 Board of Directors of the Walker River Irrigation District and as
12 President of the Nevada Farm Bureau for 10 years, during which he
13 traveled to five European countries and to Japan on trade missions;
14 and

15 WHEREAS, His community service also included membership in
16 and two terms as President of the Rotary Club of Yerington, by
17 which he was recognized as a Paul Harris Fellow, service on the
18 Board of the Mason Valley Fire Protection District, membership in
19 the Walker Basin Project Stakeholders Group and the establishment
20 of a popular, local radio talk show; and

21 WHEREAS, In an effort to improve people's lives in our State
22 and throughout the world, this dedicated Nevadan served on the
23 Desert Research Institute Research Foundation Board; and

24 WHEREAS, One of the greatest attestations to a life well-lived is
25 the praise of those who know a person best, and Davey's friends,
26 neighbors and those with whom he worked offer the highest praise
27 for him and express the hole his absence leaves in their hearts and in
28 all of Lyon County because of his unique place in the community;

30 WHEREAS, David Fulstone is survived by his wife Diane, his
31 two sons Joshua and Jeffrey, his father David, his sister DeeAnn and
32 innumerable friends; now, therefore, be it

33 RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, THE
34 SENATE CONCURRING, That the members of the 75th Nevada
35 Legislature wish to express their sincerest condolences to the family
36 and friends of Davey Fulstone; and be it further
