

ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 10–  
ASSEMBLYWOMAN BUCKLEY

**SUMMARY**—Urges Congress to enact legislation requiring the Secretary of the Interior to convey ownership of certain land to the State of Nevada for the development of projects for renewable energy. (BDR R-686)

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ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION—Urging Congress to enact legislation requiring the Secretary of the Interior to convey ownership of certain land to the State of Nevada for the development of projects for renewable energy.

1 WHEREAS, Each year, the United States relies heavily upon  
2 energy that is produced by using finite resources such as coal,  
3 natural gas and petroleum; and

4 WHEREAS, The cost of crude oil imported into the United States  
5 from foreign sources has been very unpredictable; and

6 WHEREAS, At its peak, the drastic increase in the cost of oil in  
7 2008 created significant turmoil among citizens throughout the  
8 United States, many of whom found the cost to be too high to even  
9 drive to work; and

10 WHEREAS, That increased cost also had the effect of increasing  
11 the price of nearly all other products offered to consumers; and

12 WHEREAS, In 2007, approximately 72 quadrillion British  
13 thermal units of energy were produced in the United States; and

14 WHEREAS, Of that amount, approximately 9 percent was  
15 produced using renewable resources such as geothermal energy,  
16 solar and wind power and biomass; and

1        WHEREAS, In 2007, approximately 102 quadrillion British  
2 thermal units of energy were consumed in the United States, thereby  
3 creating an energy deficiency of approximately 30 percent; and

4        WHEREAS, During troubled economic times, it is more  
5 important than ever that the United States find stability in the cost of  
6 energy and have the opportunity to become the leader in the  
7 production of renewable energy; and

8        WHEREAS, Nevada has significant amounts of geothermal, solar  
9 and wind resources available for use in the production of renewable  
10 sources of energy, including the largest geothermal resources of any  
11 state; and

12        WHEREAS, Nevada has made a significant commitment to  
13 developing renewable resources by enacting NRS 704.7821, which  
14 requires that, by 2015, not less than 20 percent of the electricity sold  
15 by providers of electric service to retail customers in Nevada must  
16 be generated, acquired or saved using renewable energy systems or  
17 energy efficient measures; and

18        WHEREAS, President Obama has recognized the importance of  
19 developing sustainable renewable energy resources and the  
20 corresponding opportunity to create employment by including  
21 funding for states to develop these resources in the American  
22 Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009; and

23        WHEREAS, The unemployment rate in Nevada has become one  
24 of the highest in the country; and

25        WHEREAS, The development of projects for renewable energy in  
26 Nevada would stimulate the economy by providing a stable source  
27 of employment and revenue; and

28        WHEREAS, Much of the land in Nevada is managed or  
29 controlled by the Bureau of Land Management and may also be  
30 suitable for use in the development of projects for renewable energy  
31 in Nevada; now, therefore, be it

32        RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY AND SENATE OF THE STATE OF  
33 NEVADA, JOINTLY, That Congress is hereby urged to enact  
34 legislation requiring the Secretary of the Interior:

35        1. After considering any recommendations submitted by each  
36 appropriate governmental agency of the State of Nevada, to identify  
37 any parcels or other portions of land in Nevada which are managed  
38 or controlled by the Bureau of Land Management and which are  
39 suitable for the development of projects for renewable energy in  
40 Nevada; and

41        2. After identifying those parcels or portions of land, to convey  
42 ownership of those parcels or portions of land to the State of Nevada  
43 for the development of those projects; and be it further

44        RESOLVED, That the Chief Clerk of the Assembly prepare and  
45 transmit a copy of this resolution to the Vice President of the United



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1 States as the presiding officer of the United States Senate, the  
2 Speaker of the House of Representatives, the Secretary of the  
3 Interior and each member of the Nevada Congressional Delegation;  
4 and be it further

5 RESOLVED, That this resolution becomes effective upon  
6 passage.

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
