SUMMARY—Requires public schools to post a notice of certain information concerning educational programs and services available within the school district. (BDR 34-621)

AN ACT relating to education; requiring each public school to post a notice of information concerning certain courses, services and programs available to pupils enrolled in the school district; requiring that the notice be ~~provided~~ **made available** to the parents and legal guardians of those pupils; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel’s Digest:

1 This bill requires the board of trustees of each school district to prepare a notice of
2 information identifying all the advanced placement courses, honors courses, international
3 baccalaureate courses, special education services, **charter school programs** and any other
4 educational programs available to pupils enrolled in the school district, including where those
5 courses, services and programs are offered. Each public school within the school district is
6 required to post ~~the~~ a notice in a conspicuous place at the school **indicating the availability**
7 **and location of a complete list of the courses, services and programs identified by the**
8 **school district and make that** ~~and provide the~~ notice **available** to the parents and legal
9 guardians of pupils enrolled in the school.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 392 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new
2 section to read as follows:

3 *1. The board of trustees of each school district shall prepare a written*
4 *notice which identifies all the advanced placement courses, honors courses,*
5 *international baccalaureate courses, special education services and any other*
6 *educational programs available to pupils enrolled in the school district including,*
7 *without limitation, to the extent information is available, programs offered by*

1 charter schools within the school district, which will assist in the advancement of
2 the education of those pupils. The notice must:

3 (a) Specify where those courses, services and programs are available within
4 the school district;

5 (b) Identify the grade level of pupils for which those courses, services and
6 programs are available; and

7 (c) Be posted on the Internet website maintained by the school district.

8 2. Each public school shall:

9 (a) Post in one or more conspicuous places at the school ~~the~~ a notice
10 ~~prepared~~ indicating the availability and location of a complete list of the
11 courses, services and programs identified pursuant to subsection 1; and

12 (b) Ensure that the notice prepared pursuant to subsection 1 is ~~provided~~
13 made available to the parents and legal guardians of pupils enrolled in the school
14 at the beginning of each school year or upon a pupil's enrollment in public
15 school, as applicable.

16 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2009.
