AN ACT relating to the Department of Cultural Affairs; ~~[eliminating]~~ **temporarily suspending** the requirement that the State Library and Archives be open to the public during certain days and hours; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 This bill ~~[eliminates]~~ **suspends for 2 years** the requirement in existing law that the State
2 Library and Archives be open for the use of the public for at least 5 days in each week and for
3 at least 8 hours in each day with the exception of legal holidays. (NRS 378.070)

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 378.070 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 378.070 The State Library and Archives Administrator may designate the
3 hours that the State Library and Archives must be open for the use of the public . ~~[~~
4 ~~but they must be open for at least 5 days in each week and for at least 8 hours in~~
5 ~~each day with the exception of legal holidays.]~~
6 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2009 ~~[]~~, **and expires by**
7 **limitation on June 30, 2011.**
