SUMMARY—Makes an appropriation for the continuation of programs dedicated to promoting citizen volunteerism. (BDR S-1291)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the Department of Administration for allocation to Nevada Volunteers for continuation of its programs dedicated to promoting citizen volunteerism; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to
2 the Department of Administration the sum of ~~\$365,000~~ \$200,000 for allocation to
3 Nevada Volunteers to match federal funding for continuation of its programs
4 dedicated to promoting citizen volunteerism.

5 2. Upon acceptance of the money appropriated by subsection 1 and allocated
6 by the Department, Nevada Volunteers shall:

7 (a) Prepare and transmit a report to the Interim Finance Committee on or
8 before December 15, 2010, that describes each expenditure made from the money
9 appropriated by subsection 1 from the date on which the money was received by
10 Nevada Volunteers through December 1, 2010;

11 (b) Prepare and transmit a final report to the Interim Finance Committee on or
12 before September 16, 2011, that describes each expenditure made from the money
13 appropriated by subsection 1 from the date on which the money was received by
14 Nevada Volunteers through June 30, 2011; and

15 (c) Upon request of the Legislative Commission, make available to the
16 Legislative Auditor any of the books, accounts, claims, reports, vouchers or other
17 records of information, confidential or otherwise, of Nevada Volunteers, regardless
18 of their form or location, that the Legislative Auditor deems necessary to conduct
19 an audit of the use of the money appropriated pursuant to subsection 1.

20 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by subsection 1 of
21 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2011, by
22 the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity to which the money from
23 the appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion

1 of the appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after
2 September 16, 2011, by either the entity to which the money was appropriated or
3 the entity to which the money was subsequently granted or transferred, and must be
4 reverted to the State General Fund on or before September 16, 2011.

5 **Sec. 3.** The appropriation made by the provisions of this act is intended to
6 finance ongoing expenditures of the Department of Administration, and the
7 expenditures financed with the appropriation must be included as a base budget
8 expenditure in the proposed budget for the Executive Branch of State Government
9 for the 2011-2013 biennium.

10 **Sec. 4.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2009.
