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ASSEMBLY CONCURRENT RESOLUTION—Directing the Legislative Commission to conduct an interim study on the development and promotion of logistics and distribution centers in this State.

1 WHEREAS, The creation of new jobs and promoting diversification of the 2 Nevada economy is a critical need and an overriding goal of the Legislature; and

3 WHEREAS, Nevada is uniquely positioned by virtue of its location and 4 favorable business climate to serve as a logistics and distribution center for the 5 receipt, shipment and assembly of goods on the West Coast to points north and 6 east; and

7 WHEREAS, The Nevada System of Higher Education, including the state 8 universities in Reno and Las Vegas, has expertise in supply chain management and 9 can provide consulting support, managerial development through degree programs 10 and job training opportunities; and

11 WHEREAS, Foreign trade zones exist in both southern and northern Nevada for 12 the purpose, among other things, of facilitating the growth of logistics and 13 distribution centers; and

14 WHEREAS, The proposed Ivanpah Valley Airport in Clark County, the Tahoe- 15 Reno Industrial Center in Storey County and the Reno-Tahoe International Airport 16 are poised for future development as logistics and distribution centers and for the 17 creation of a wide range of jobs in supply chain management; and

18 WHEREAS, The Elko County Rail Port provides additional opportunities for 19 east-west distribution of goods and development of a logistics cluster; ~~knows and~~

20 ***WHEREAS, Mass transportation systems play an integral role in supporting***  
***the diversification and expansion of the workforce and economy; and***

21 ***WHEREAS, Efficient mass transportation systems reduce environmental***  
***degradation and decrease congestion on major roadways,*** now, therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, THE SENATE 23 CONCURRING, That the Legislative Commission is hereby directed to appoint a 24 subcommittee to study the development and promotion of Nevada as a logistics and 25 distribution center; and be it further

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1       RESOLVED, That the subcommittee shall formulate a strategy and develop an  
2 implementation plan detailing the steps that need to be taken to create and promote  
3 the further development of Nevada as a logistics and distribution center which must  
4 include, without limitation:

5       1. Identification of barriers to the development of logistics and distribution  
6 centers;

7       **~~2.~~ The costs and benefits associated with expanding mass transportation**  
8 **systems;**

9       **~~2.~~ Delineation of future foreign trade zones;**

10       **~~3.~~ Prioritization of infrastructure needs, including energy and water ~~H~~**  
11 **and mass transportation systems;**

12       **~~4.~~ Formation of public-private partnerships for financing and incubation**  
13 of new businesses;

14       **~~5.~~ Funding options for the expansion of mass transit systems;**

15       **~~6.~~ Attraction of businesses associated with supply chain management**  
16 activities, including assembly, manufacturing, warehousing and transportation; and

17       **~~7.~~ Identification of strategic public policy actions to expedite the**  
18 **investment of private development companies in major logistics centers in Nevada;**

20       RESOLVED, That the Legislative Commission shall submit a report of the  
21 results of the study and any recommendations for legislation to the 76th Session of  
22 the Nevada Legislature.
