SUMMARY—Provides funding to the Department of Wildlife for certain projects. (BDR S-652)

AN ACT relating to the Department of Wildlife; providing funding to the Department of Wildlife for certain projects; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel’s Digest:

1 The Legislature submitted to the voters of this State, and the voters approved, at the
2 general election held on November 5, 2002, a proposal to issue general obligation bonds of
3 the State to protect, preserve and obtain the benefits of the property and natural resources of
4 this State in an amount not to exceed \$200,000,000. Of this amount, \$27,500,000 was
5 allocated to the Division of Wildlife of the State Department of Conservation and Natural
6 Resources. (Chapter 6, Statutes of Nevada 2001, 17th Special Session, p. 104) This bill
7 requires that ~~[\$1,000,000 of the \$27,500,000]~~ **\$225,000** be allocated to the Department of
8 Wildlife ~~[to fund projects in this State that]~~ **for a coordinator and related costs to ensure**
9 **that local, state and federal entities work together to:** (1) protect and restore sagebrush
10 habitats; (2) restore areas damaged by wildfires; (3) prevent wildfires; or (4) reduce
11 cheatgrass.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter 6, Statutes of Nevada
2 2001, 17th Special Session, from the ~~[\$27,500,000 in general obligation bonds~~
3 ~~allocated to the Division of Wildlife of]~~ **Fund to Protect Natural Resources,**
4 **administered by** the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources
5 pursuant to subsection ~~[2 of section 2]~~ **5 of section 3** of that act, the sum of
6 ~~[\$1,000,000]~~ **\$225,000** must be allocated to the Department of Wildlife to **create**
7 **and fund** ~~[projects that]~~ **a position for a coordinator and related costs to ensure**
8 **local, state and federal entities are working together to:**
9 1. Protect and restore sagebrush habitats.
10 2. Restore areas damaged by wildfires.
11 3. Prevent wildfires.
12 4. Reduce cheatgrass.

1 Sec. 2. Any remaining balance of the allocation made by section 1 of this
2 act not committed for expenditure by June 30, 2011, must be reverted to the
3 Fund to Protect Natural Resources.
4 ~~{Sec. 2.}~~ Sec. 3. This act becomes effective ~~{on July 1, 2009,}~~ upon
5 passage and approval.
