## SENATE BILL NO. 168—SENATOR CARE

MARCH 4, 2009

Referred to Committee on Commerce and Labor

SUMMARY—Revises provisions relating to prescription drugs. (BDR 54-1011)

FISCAL NOTE: Effect on Local Government: Increases or Newly Provides for Term of Imprisonment in County or City Jail or Detention Facility.

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AN ACT relating to pharmacy; requiring that the label of a prescription drug contain certain warnings; providing a penalty; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

This bill requires that the label attached to any prescription drug dispensed in this State contain a written warning which must state [~~I. Caution: If the person to whom this drug is prescribed is less than 25 years of age, the person or his caregiver is advised to review the pamphlet and other information which is included with the prescription.~~] **WARNING: Review boxed warning information included with this prescription if the prescription drug is required to have a boxed warning pursuant to federal law.** (NRS 639.2801) A violation of any provision of this bill is punishable as a misdemeanor. (NRS 639.310)

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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1      **Section 1.** NRS 639.2801 is hereby amended to read as follows:

2      639.2801 ***I.*** Unless specified to the contrary in writing on the prescription  
3      by the prescribing practitioner, all prescriptions filled by any practitioner must be  
4      dispensed in a container to which is affixed a label or other device which clearly  
5      shows:

6      ~~H-1~~ ***(a)*** The date.

7      ~~H-1~~ ***(b)*** The name, address and prescription serial number of the practitioner  
8      who filled the prescription.

9      ~~H-1~~ ***(c)*** The names of the prescribing practitioner and of the person for whom  
10     prescribed.

11     ~~H-1~~ ***(d)*** The number of dosage units.

12     ~~H-1~~ ***(e)*** The symptom or purpose for which the drug is prescribed, if included  
13     by the practitioner pursuant to NRS 639.2352.

14     ~~H-1~~ ***(f)*** Specific directions for use given by the prescribing practitioner.

1       ~~17.~~ (g) The expiration date of the effectiveness of the drug or medicine  
2 dispensed, if that information is included on the original label of the manufacturer  
3 of that drug or medicine. If the expiration date specified by the manufacturer is not  
4 less than 1 year after the date of dispensing, the practitioner may use a date that is 1  
5 year after the date of dispensing as the expiration date.

7 the prescribing practitioner.
