AN ACT relating to taxation; requiring the Department of Taxation to create and make publicly available on an Internet website a searchable database of the rates of ~~the~~ certain taxes levied by this State or a local government; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 This bill requires the Department of Taxation to create and make publicly available on an
2 Internet website established and maintained by the Department a searchable database of the
3 rates of ~~the~~ certain taxes levied by this State or a local government. The website must
4 provide a user with the rate of each such state and local tax which may be applicable to the
5 user and the combined rate of all such taxes. For the purposes of this bill, "local government"
6 means every political subdivision or other entity which has the right to levy or receive money
7 from ad valorem taxes or other taxes, including, without limitation, counties, cities, towns,
8 school districts and certain other districts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 360 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

1. The Department shall create and make publicly available on an Internet website established and maintained by the Department a searchable database of the rates of all taxes levied by ~~this~~ :

(a) This State pursuant to this title which are administered by the Department; or ~~the~~

(b) A local government.

2. ~~The~~ To the extent of available money and resources, the database must be accessible by entering a zip code or street address. ~~for by clicking on a map of~~

1 ~~this State that allows a user to access the tax rates that may be applicable within~~
2 ~~the jurisdiction of a local government selected by the user.~~

3 3. The database must provide a user with:

4 (a) The rate of each such state and local tax which may be applicable to a
5 taxpayer who resides ~~[within the jurisdiction of the local government selected by~~
6 ~~the user on the map or]~~ within the zip code or at the street address entered by the
7 user on the website; and

8 (b) The combined rate of all those taxes.

9 4. ~~[[The]]~~ To the extent of available money and resources, the website ~~[must]~~
10 should be designed to provide ~~[[a]]~~:

11 (a) A user with access to tax-rate calculators that allow the user to calculate
12 the amount of taxes that he may be liable to pay, including, without limitation,
13 property taxes, sales and use taxes and business taxes, based on the tax rates
14 provided to the user pursuant to subsection 3 ~~[[a]]~~; and

15 (b) A map search function which allows a user, by clicking on a map of this
16 State, to access the tax rates that may be applicable within the jurisdiction of a
17 local government selected by the user and the combined rate of all those taxes.

18 5. As used in this section, "local government" means every political
19 subdivision or other entity which has the right to levy or receive money from ad
20 valorem taxes or other taxes, including, without limitation, counties, cities, towns,
21 school districts and other districts organized pursuant to chapters 244, 309, 318,
22 379, 450, 473, 474, 539, 541, 543 and 555 of NRS.

23 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective on January 1, 2010.
