AN ACT relating to highways; ~~providing for the evaluation and establishment of~~ the maximum speed on certain portions of State Route 159; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

This bill establishes the State Route 159 Safety Speed Reduction Zone to ~~limit vehicular traffic to not more than 45 miles per hour on any portion~~ provide for the evaluation and establishment of the maximum speed on portions of State Route 159 that: (1) ~~are~~ within the Red Rock Canyon National Conservation Area; (2) ~~abuts or is abut or~~ ~~are~~ immediately adjacent to the Red Rock Canyon National Conservation Area; or (3) ~~have~~ been designated as a Scenic Byway or State Scenic Byway.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1           **Section 1.** The Legislature hereby finds and declares that:

- 2           1. Because of the unique character of the Red Rock Canyon National  
3 Conservation Area, restrictions on the maximum speed for vehicular traffic in and  
4 around the Red Rock Canyon National Conservation Area are necessary for:  
5           (a) The protection of the natural environment in and around the Red Rock  
6 Canyon National Conservation Area; and  
7           (b) The safety and protection of the residents and visitors who enjoy the scenic  
8 beauty and recreational opportunities in and around the Red Rock Canyon National  
9 Conservation Area.

1       2. The enactment of this act is not intended to encourage the imposition of  
2 similar restrictions on other designated highways in this State.

3       **Sec. 2.** Chapter 484 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new  
4 section to read as follows:

5       1. ***The State Route 159 Safety Speed Reduction Zone is hereby  
6 established.***

7       2. ***Within the State Route 159 Safety Speed Reduction Zone, the  
8 Department of Transportation, in cooperation with other governmental entities  
9 whose jurisdiction includes this area, shall ensure that:***

10      (a) ***The maximum speed that is allowed for vehicular traffic ~~is~~ will be set by  
11 the Director of the Department of Transportation at a level which ~~does not~~  
12 exceed 45 miles per hour, and*** takes into consideration the safety and protection  
13 of the residents of and visitors to the Red Rock Canyon National Conservation  
14 Area. In setting that maximum speed, the Director of the Department of  
15 Transportation shall consider, without limitation, the following factors:

16       (1) ***Activity of bicycles and pedestrians in the area.***

17       (2) ***Protection of the natural environment.***

18       (3) ***History of accidents and crashes in the area.***

19       (4) ***Recreational activities conducted in the area.***

20       (5) ***The evaluation and use of measures of traffic calming which will  
21 support the maximum speed that is set.***

22       (6) ***The ability of law enforcement agencies to enforce effectively the  
23 maximum speed that is set.***

24       (b) ***Adequate signage or other forms of notice are ~~posted and maintained to  
25 advise motorists of that maximum allowable speed,~~ evaluated and installed to  
26 support and enhance the maximum speed that is set by the Director of the  
27 Department of Transportation, as described in paragraph (a).***

28       3. ***The State Route 159 Safety Speed Reduction Zone consists of:***

29       (a) Any portion of State Route 159 that is within the Red Rock Canyon  
30 National Conservation Area;

31       (b) Any portion of State Route 159 that abuts or is immediately adjacent to  
32 the Red Rock Canyon National Conservation Area; and

33       (c) Any portion of State Route 159 that has been designated as a Scenic  
34 Byway or State Scenic Byway.

35       4. ***As used in this section ~~H~~:***

36       (a) ***“Scenic Byway” and “State Scenic Byway” have the meanings ascribed  
37 to them in the National Scenic Byways Program, as issued by the Federal  
38 Highway Administration in 60 Federal Register 26,759 on May 18, 1995.***

39       (b) ***“Traffic calming” means a combination of measures and techniques  
40 intended to:***

41       (1) ***Reduce vehicular speeds;***

42       (2) ***Promote safe and pleasant conditions for motorists, bicyclists,  
43 pedestrians and residents;***

44       (3) ***Improve the environment and usability of roadways;***

45       (4) ***Improve real and perceived safety for nonmotorized traffic; or***

46       (5) ***Any combination of subparagraphs (1) to (4), inclusive.***

47       **Sec. 3. 1. On or before February 1, 2011, the Director of the  
48 Department of Transportation shall submit a report on the effectiveness of the  
49 State Route 159 Safety Speed Zone and any recommendations for legislation to  
50 the Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau for transmission to the 76th  
51 Session of the Nevada Legislature.**

52       2. As used in this section, “State Route 159 Safety Speed Zone” means the  
53 zone established pursuant to section 2 of this act.
