SUMMARY—Requiring the Legislative Committee on Health Care to study certain issues concerning the provision of ~~public~~ health ~~care~~. (BDR S-1061)

AN ACT relating to ~~health districts;~~ health care; requiring the Legislative Committee on Health Care to study the establishment of a health district in a county whose population is less than 100,000; requiring the ~~Legislative~~ Committee ~~on Health Care~~ to study issues concerning the consolidation and integration of ~~public~~ health and social services in ~~a county whose population is 400,000 or more;~~ certain larger counties; requiring the Committee to study the establishment of regional centers for certain substance abuse treatment; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

1 This bill requires the Legislative Committee on Health Care to study: (1) the feasibility of  
2 establishing a health district in a county whose population is less than 100,000 (currently  
3 counties other than Clark and Washoe Counties); ~~and~~ (2) the feasibility of consolidating or  
4 integrating certain ~~public~~ health and social services provided in a county whose population  
5 is 400,000 or more (currently Clark County), ~~;~~ and (3) the feasibility of establishing  
6 regional centers for the provision of services for the prevention and treatment of alcohol  
7 and substance abuse.
