AN ACT making an appropriation to the State Fire Marshal Division of the Department of Public Safety for refunds of certain fees; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1. 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to
2 the State Fire Marshal Division of the Department of Public Safety the sum of
3 ~~[\$10,890]~~ **\$6,898** for refunds of hazardous material fees and plan review **and**
4 **licensing** fees.

5 **2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by subsection 1**
6 **must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2009, by the entity to**
7 **which the appropriation is made or any entity to which money from the**
8 **appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any**
9 **portion of the appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any**
10 **purpose after September 18, 2009, by either the entity to which the money was**
11 **appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently granted or**
12 **transferred, and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or before**
13 **September 18, 2009.**

14 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
