AN ACT making appropriations to restore ~~[the]~~ certain fund balances ~~[in the State Claims Account, Emergency Account and Reserve for Statutory Contingency Account.]~~ and for certain costs related to changes in various taxes; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the:

2 1. Stale Claims Account created by NRS 353.097 the sum of \$5,500,000 to

3 restore the balance in the Account.

4 2. Emergency Account created by NRS 353.263 the sum of \$150,000 to

5 restore the balance in the Account.

6 3. Reserve for Statutory Contingency Account created by NRS 353.264 the

7 sum of \$3,000,000 to restore the balance in the Account.

8 4. Contingency Fund created by NRS 353.266 the sum of \$7,500,000 to

9 restore the balance in the fund attributable to the State General Fund.

10 Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to

11 the:

12 1. Department of Motor Vehicles the sum of \$24,000 for the costs of

13 implementing changes to the provisions governing the governmental services

14 tax.

15 2. Department of Taxation the sum of \$95,000 for the costs of

16 implementing changes to the provisions governing the local school support tax.

1 3. Interim Finance Committee the sum of \$527,850 for allocation to the
2 Department of Taxation for the costs of additional duties and modifications
3 necessary to implement laws revised during this session.

4 Sec. 3. Any remaining balance of the appropriations made by section 2
5 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2011, by the
6 entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity to which money from
7 the appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any
8 portion of the appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any
9 purpose after September 16, 2011, by either the entity to which the money was
10 appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently granted or
11 transferred, and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or before
12 September 16, 2011.

13 ~~{Sec. 2}~~ Sec. 4. 1. This section and sections 2 and 3 of this act become
14 effective upon passage and approval.

15 2. Section 1 of this act becomes effective on July 1, 2009.
