

SENATE BILL NO. 109—COMMITTEE ON NATURAL RESOURCES  
(ON BEHALF OF THE LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC LANDS)

**SUMMARY**—Deletes the provisions that place each state grazing board within the State Department of Agriculture.  
(BDR 50-495)

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AN ACT relating to state grazing boards; deleting the provisions that place such boards within the State Department of Agriculture; requiring each state grazing board to submit an annual report to the Legislature; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

1 Existing law creates a state grazing board for each Bureau of Land  
2 Management grazing district in Nevada and places each of those boards within the  
3 State Department of Agriculture. (NRS 568.040) This bill deletes the provisions  
4 that place each of those boards within the Department and requires each state  
5 grazing board to submit to the Legislature an annual report of its revenues and  
6 expenditures.

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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1      **Section 1.** NRS 568.040 is hereby amended to read as follows:  
2      568.040 **1.** To direct and guide the disposition of the range  
3 improvement fund of each grazing district concerned, in the manner  
4 most beneficial to the stock raising payers of the grazing fees from  
5 which the funds are derived and to the counties concerned, there is  
6 hereby created **[within the State Department of Agriculture]** a state  
7 grazing board for each Bureau of Land Management grazing district

1 established and existing in Nevada under the provisions of the  
2 Taylor Grazing Act.

3     ***2. Each state grazing board created by subsection 1 shall***  
4     ***submit an annual report of its revenues and expenditures to the***  
5     ***Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau not later than***  
6     ***February 15 of each year for transmittal to the Legislature.***
