

SENATE BILL NO. 134—SENATOR COFFIN

FEBRUARY 12, 2009

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Referred to Committee on Energy, Infrastructure and Transportation

**SUMMARY**—Revises provisions concerning the increased penalty imposed for certain traffic violations occurring in work zones. (BDR 43-180)

**FISCAL NOTE:** Effect on Local Government: May have Fiscal Impact.

Effect on the State: Yes.

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EXPLANATION – Matter in ***bolded italics*** is new; matter between brackets [~~omitted material~~] is material to be omitted.

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AN ACT relating to traffic laws; revising provisions concerning the increased penalty imposed for certain traffic violations that occur in work zones; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

1 Existing law requires the doubling of the penalty imposed against a person  
2 convicted of speeding or convicted of certain other traffic offenses that occur in a  
3 highway construction zone if: (1) workers are present; or (2) the effects of the  
4 offense are otherwise aggravated because of certain highway conditions that exist  
5 as a result of the highway construction. (NRS 484.3667) This bill maintains the  
6 double penalty if such an offense occurs in a highway construction zone when  
7 workers are present. However, this bill provides that a court may, but is not  
8 required to, impose a reduced additional penalty of not more than one-half the  
9 penalty imposed for the primary offense if the offense occurs in a highway  
10 construction zone when workers are not present but where the effects of the offense  
11 are still otherwise aggravated because of certain highway conditions that exist as a  
12 result of the highway construction.

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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1      **Section 1.** NRS 484.254 is hereby amended to read as follows:  
2      484.254 1. It is unlawful for a driver of a vehicle to fail or  
3 refuse to comply with any signal of an authorized flagman serving  
4 in a traffic control capacity in a clearly marked area of highway  
5 construction or maintenance.



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1       2. A district attorney shall prosecute all violations of  
2 subsection 1 which occur in his jurisdiction and which result in  
3 injury to any person performing highway construction or  
4 maintenance unless the district attorney has good cause for not  
5 prosecuting the violation. In addition to any other penalty, if a driver  
6 violates any provision of subsection 1 and the violation results in  
7 injury to any person performing highway construction or  
8 maintenance, or in damage to property in an amount of not less than  
9 \$1,000, the driver shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$1,000  
10 or more than \$2,000, and ordered to perform 120 hours of  
11 community service.

12     3. A person who violates any provision of subsection 1 may be  
13 subject to the additional penalty set forth in **subsection 1 of**  
14 NRS 484.3667.

15     4. As used in this section, "authorized flagman serving in a  
16 traffic control capacity" means:

17       (a) An employee of the Department of Transportation or of a  
18 contractor performing highway construction or maintenance for the  
19 Department of Transportation while he is carrying out the duties of  
20 his employment;

21       (b) An employee of any other governmental entity or of a  
22 contractor performing highway construction or maintenance for the  
23 governmental entity while he is carrying out the duties of his  
24 employment; or

25       (c) Any other person employed by a private entity performing  
26 highway construction or maintenance while he is carrying out the  
27 duties of his employment if the person has satisfactorily completed  
28 training as a flagman approved or recognized by the Department of  
29 Transportation.

30     **Sec. 2.** NRS 484.3667 is hereby amended to read as follows:

31     484.3667 1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection [2,]  
32 **3, if a person [who]** is convicted of a violation of a speed limit, or of  
33 NRS 484.254, 484.278, 484.289, 484.2895, 484.291 to 484.301,  
34 inclusive, 484.305, 484.309, 484.311, 484.335, 484.337, 484.361,  
35 484.363, 484.3765, 484.377, 484.3775, 484.379, 484.379778,  
36 484.448, 484.453 or 484.479, that occurred:

37       (a) In an area designated as a temporary traffic control zone in  
38 which construction, maintenance or repair of a highway is  
39 conducted; and

40       (b) At a time when the workers who are performing the  
41 construction, maintenance or repair of the highway are present, **for**  
42 **when the effects of the act may be aggravated because of the**  
43 **condition of the highway caused by construction, maintenance or**  
44 **repair, including, without limitation, reduction in lane width,**  
45 **reduction in the number of lanes, shifting of lanes from the**



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1     designated alignment and uneven or temporary surfaces, including,  
2     without limitation, modifications to road beds, cement-treated bases,  
3     chip seals and other similar conditions,  
4     → shall be punished]

5     → **the appropriate court shall punish the person** by imprisonment  
6     or by a fine, or both, for a term or an amount equal to and in  
7     addition to the term of imprisonment or amount of the fine, or both,  
8     that the court imposes for the primary offense. Any term of  
9     imprisonment imposed pursuant to this subsection runs  
10    consecutively with the sentence prescribed by the court for the  
11    crime. This subsection does not create a separate offense, but  
12    provides an additional penalty for the primary offense, whose  
13    imposition is contingent upon the finding of the prescribed fact.

14    2. **Except as otherwise provided in this subsection and**  
15    **subsection 3, if a person is convicted of a violation of a speed limit,**  
16    **or of NRS 484.278, 484.289, 484.2895, 484.291 to 484.301,**  
17    **inclusive, 484.305, 484.309, 484.311, 484.335, 484.337, 484.361,**  
18    **484.363, 484.3765, 484.377, 484.3775, 484.379, 484.379778,**  
19    **484.448, 484.453 or 484.479, that occurred:**

20    (a) **In an area designated as a temporary traffic control zone**  
21    **in which construction, maintenance or repair of a highway is**  
22    **conducted; and**

23    (b) **At a time when the workers who are performing the**  
24    **construction, maintenance or repair of the highway are not**  
25    **present, but when the effects of the act may be aggravated because**  
26    **of the condition of the highway caused by construction,**  
27    **maintenance or repair, including, without limitation, reduction in**  
28    **lane width, reduction in the number of lanes, shifting of lanes**  
29    **from the designated alignment and uneven or temporary surfaces,**  
30    **including, without limitation, modifications to road beds, cement-**  
31    **treated bases, chip seals and other similar conditions,**

32    → **the appropriate court may punish the person by imprisonment**  
33    **or by a fine, or both, for a term or an amount in addition to the**  
34    **term of imprisonment or amount of the fine, or both, that the court**  
35    **imposes for the primary offense. Any additional term of**  
36    **imprisonment or fine, or both, imposed pursuant to this subsection**  
37    **must not exceed 50 percent of the term of imprisonment or fine, or**  
38    **both, that the court imposes for the primary offense. Any term of**  
39    **imprisonment imposed pursuant to this subsection runs**  
40    **consecutively with the sentence prescribed by the court for the**  
41    **crime. This subsection does not create a separate offense, but**  
42    **provides an additional penalty for the primary offense, whose**  
43    **imposition is contingent upon the finding of the prescribed fact.**



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1       **3.** The additional penalty imposed pursuant to subsection 1 **or**  
2       **2** must not exceed a total of \$1,000, 6 months of imprisonment or  
3       120 hours of community service.

4       **[3.] 4.** A governmental entity that designates an area as a  
5       temporary traffic control zone in which construction, maintenance  
6       or repair of a highway is conducted, or the person with whom the  
7       governmental entity contracts to provide such service, shall cause to  
8       be erected:

9       (a) A sign located before the beginning of such an area stating  
10      ~~“DOUBLE”~~ **“INCREASED PENALTIES IN WORK ZONES”** to  
11      indicate **[a double]** **that an increased** penalty may be imposed  
12      pursuant to this section;

13       (b) A sign to mark the beginning of the temporary traffic control  
14      zone; and

15       (c) A sign to mark the end of the temporary traffic control zone.

16       **[4.] 5.** A person who otherwise would be subject to an  
17      additional penalty pursuant to this section is not relieved of any  
18      criminal liability because signs are not erected as required by  
19      subsection **[3.] 4** if the violation results in injury to any person  
20      performing highway construction or maintenance in the temporary  
21      traffic control zone or in damage to property in an amount equal to  
22      \$1,000 or more.

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
