

SENATE BILL NO. 135—SENATOR COFFIN

FEBRUARY 12, 2009

Referred to Committee on Health and Education

SUMMARY—Requires pupils enrolled in certain grades in public schools to wear school uniforms. (BDR 34-662)

AN ACT relating to education; requiring the boards of trustees of school districts to adopt a policy requiring pupils enrolled in kindergarten through grade 3 to wear school uniforms; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel’s Digest:

1 Existing law authorizes the boards of trustees of school districts to establish a  
2 policy that requires pupils in all grades to wear school uniforms. (NRS 392.458)  
3 This bill requires the boards of trustees to establish and enforce a policy that  
4 requires pupils enrolled in kindergarten through grade 3 to wear school uniforms  
5 and maintains the authority for the boards of trustees to adopt such a policy for all  
6 other grade levels.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 392.458 is hereby amended to read as follows:  
2 392.458 1. *The board of trustees of each school district*  
3 *shall, in consultation with the elementary schools within the*  
4 *district, parents and legal guardians of pupils who are enrolled in*  
5 *elementary schools in the district, and associations and*  
6 *organizations representing licensed educational personnel within*  
7 *the district, establish and enforce a policy that requires pupils*  
8 *enrolled in kindergarten through grade 3 to wear school uniforms.*  
9 2. The board of trustees of a school district may, in  
10 consultation with the schools within the district, parents and legal  
11 guardians of pupils who are enrolled in the district, and associations



1 and organizations representing licensed educational personnel  
2 within the district, establish *and enforce* a policy that requires  
3 pupils *enrolled in any grade level for grades 4 to 12, inclusive*, to  
4 wear school uniforms.

6 **3.** A policy *established pursuant to this section* must:

7 (a) Describe the uniforms ~~[ ]~~, *including, without limitation, the*  
8 *permissible variations in the uniforms taking into account the*  
9 *variations of weather and temperature in the district;*

10 (b) Designate which pupils must wear the uniforms; and

11 (c) Designate the hours or events during which the uniforms  
12 must be worn.

14 **4.** ~~The~~ board of trustees of ~~[a]~~ *each* school district ~~[establishes~~

16 shall facilitate the acquisition of school uniforms for pupils *who are*  
17 *required to wear uniforms pursuant to a policy adopted pursuant*  
18 *to this section and* whose parents or legal guardians request  
19 financial assistance to purchase the uniforms.

21 a dress code enforceable during school hours for the teachers and  
22 other personnel employed by the board of trustees.
