SUMMARY—Prohibits certain persons from using a telephonic device to write, send or read a text-based communication while operating a motor vehicle. (BDR 43-776)

AN ACT relating to traffic laws; prohibiting certain persons from using a telephonic device to write, send or read a text-based communication while operating a motor vehicle; providing a penalty; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel’s Digest:

1 This bill prohibits a person from using a telephonic device to write, send or
2 read a text-based communication while operating a motor vehicle except in certain
3 circumstances. A person who violates this provision must pay a fine of \$20 for a
4 first offense and a fine of \$50 for a second or subsequent offense. This bill does not
5 create a moving violation.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 484 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3 1. *Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2, a person*
4 *shall not use a telephonic device to write, send or read a text-based*
5 *communication while operating a motor vehicle.*

6 2. *The provisions of subsection 1 do not apply to:*

7 (a) *An emergency medical attendant, firefighter or law*
8 *enforcement officer who uses a telephonic device in the course of*
9 *his duties; or*

10 (b) *A person who reads, selects or enters a telephone number*
11 *or name in a telephonic device for the purpose of making or*
12 *receiving a telephone call.*

13 3. *A person who violates the provisions of subsection 1 shall:*

14 (a) *For a first offense, pay a fine of \$20.*

15 (b) *For a second or subsequent offense, pay a fine of \$50.*

16 4. *A violation of subsection 1 is not a moving traffic violation*
17 *under NRS 483.473.*

18 5. *As used in this section:*

19 (a) *“Emergency medical attendant” means a person licensed*
20 *as an attendant or certified as an emergency medical technician,*
21 *intermediate emergency medical technician or advanced*
22 *emergency medical technician pursuant to chapter 450B of NRS.*

23 (b) *“Telephonic device” has the meaning ascribed to it in*
24 *NRS 707.375.*

25 (c) *“Text-based communication” includes, without limitation,*
26 *communication by text message, instant message or electronic*
27 *mail.*
