

SENATE BILL NO. 140—SENATOR RAGGIO (BY REQUEST)

FEBRUARY 16, 2009

Referred to Committee on Commerce and Labor

SUMMARY—Requires a funeral establishment to have a funeral director available within a certain distance during business hours. (BDR 54-683)

AN ACT relating to funeral establishments; requiring a funeral establishment to have a funeral director available within 20 miles of the establishment during business hours; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

1 This bill requires the owner of a funeral establishment to have a funeral director
2 available within 20 miles of the establishment during business hours.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 642.363 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 642.363 1. The owner of a funeral establishment shall not
3 operate or allow another person to operate the establishment unless
4 the owner has been issued a permit by the Board to operate the
5 funeral establishment.
6 2. If a person owns more than one funeral establishment, he
7 must submit an application and obtain a permit for each funeral
8 establishment he owns.
9 *3. During business hours, the owner of a funeral*
10 *establishment shall have a funeral director available within 20*
11 *miles of the establishment.*
