AN ACT relating to state financial administration; extending the date for the reversion of money transferred to provide historical interpretive signs for the California Trail Wayside Sites to be located in eight northern Nevada counties of this State; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 7 of chapter 454, Statutes of Nevada 2005, at page 2089, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 7. 1. The Commission on Tourism shall, as soon as practicable after July 1, 2006, without depleting the funds necessary for day-to-day operations, transfer \$300,000 from the proceeds from the taxes imposed on the revenue from the rental of transient lodging which have been credited to the Fund for the Promotion of Tourism, created by NRS 231.250, to the Division of State Parks of the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources to provide for and display historical interpretive signs for the California Trail

3 2. Any remaining balance of the sum transferred
4 pursuant to subsection 1 must not be committed for
5 expenditure after ~~June 30,~~ *December 31*, 2009, and must be
6 reverted to the Fund for the Promotion of Tourism on or
7 before ~~September 18, 2009,~~ *September 17, 2010*.

8 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
