**SUMMARY**—Revises provisions relating to taxicabs.  
(BDR 58-434)

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AN ACT relating to taxicabs; providing that a taxicab driver shall not alter or otherwise change a medallion; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

1      **Section 1** of this bill provides that a taxicab driver shall not alter or otherwise  
2      change any medallion which may be issued by the Taxicab Authority.

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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1      **Section 1.** NRS 706.8849 is hereby amended to read as  
2      follows:

- 3      706.8849 1. A taxicab driver shall:  
4       (a) Ensure that the fare indicator on the taximeter of his taxicab  
5      reads zero before the time that the taxicab is engaged.  
6       (b) Ensure that the taximeter of his taxicab is engaged while the  
7      taxicab is on hire.  
8       (c) Not make any charge for the transportation of a passenger  
9      other than the charge shown on the taximeter.  
10      (d) Not alter, manipulate, tamper with or disconnect a sealed  
11     taximeter or its attachments nor make any change in the mechanical

1 condition of the wheels, tires or gears of a taxicab with intent to  
2 cause false registration on the taximeter of the passenger fare.

3 (e) Not remove or alter fare schedules which have been posted  
4 in his taxicab by the certificate holder.

5 (f) Not permit any person or persons other than the person who  
6 has engaged the taxicab to ride therein unless the person who has  
7 engaged the taxicab requests that the other person or persons ride in  
8 the taxicab. If more than one person is loaded by the taxicab driver  
9 as set forth in this paragraph, the driver shall, when one of the  
10 persons leaves the taxicab, charge that person the fare on the meter  
11 and reset the taximeter.

12 (g) Not drive a taxicab or go on duty while under the influence  
13 of, or impaired by, any controlled substance, dangerous drug ~~H~~ or  
14 intoxicating liquor , or drink intoxicating liquor while on duty.

15 (h) Not use or consume controlled substances or dangerous  
16 drugs which impair a person's ability to operate a motor vehicle at  
17 any time, or use or consume any other controlled substances or  
18 dangerous drugs at any time except in accordance with a lawfully  
19 issued prescription.

20 (i) Not operate a taxicab without a valid driver's permit issued  
21 pursuant to NRS 706.8841 and a valid driver's license issued  
22 pursuant to NRS 483.325 in his possession.

23 (j) Obey all provisions and restrictions of his employer's  
24 certificate of public convenience and necessity.

25 (k) ***Not alter, manipulate, tamper with, destroy, remove or  
reposition any medallion.***

26 2. If a driver violates any provision of subsection 1, the  
27 Administrator may, after a hearing, impose the following sanctions:

28 (a) For a first offense, 1 to 5 days' suspension of a driver's  
29 permit or a fine of not more than \$100, or both suspension and fine.

30 (b) For a second offense, 6 to 20 days' suspension of a driver's  
31 permit or a fine of not more than \$300, or both suspension and fine.

32 (c) For a third offense, a fine of not more than \$500.

33 ➔ In addition to the other penalties set forth in this subsection, the  
34 Administrator may revoke a driver's permit for any violation of a  
35 provision of paragraph (g) of subsection 1.

36 3. Only violations occurring in the 12 months immediately  
37 preceding the most current violation may be considered for the  
38 purposes of subsection 2. The Administrator shall inspect the  
39 driver's record for that period to compute the number of offenses  
40 committed.

41 ***4. As used in this section, "medallion" means a metal plate  
42 which may be issued by the Taxicab Authority in accordance with  
43 regulations adopted pursuant to this chapter.***
