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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1      **Section 1.** 1. During the 2009-2011 interim, the Legislative  
2      Committee on Health Care shall consider the establishment of a  
3      health insurance exchange that provides information on health  
4      insurance options and health care products, including, to the extent  
5      practicable, an examination of:

1       (a) Whether a health insurance exchange would provide persons  
2 in this State with greater access, choice, portability and affordability  
3 of health insurance coverage;

4           (b) The potential scope of a health insurance exchange;

5           (c) The potential powers and duties of a health insurance  
6 exchange;

7           (d) The benefits and value of a health insurance exchange to this  
8 State, including, without limitation, the extent to which the  
9 exchange may lower the cost of health care coverage;

10         (e) The use of a health insurance exchange to receive and  
11 process employee premiums on a pretax basis pursuant to 26 U.S.C.  
12 § 125;

13         (f) The eligibility criteria that a person or insurer must meet to  
14 participate in a health insurance exchange; and

15         (g) The types of health care plans that may be offered through a  
16 health insurance exchange and the extent to which each such health  
17 care plan should be available for purchase only through the  
18 exchange.

19       2. As used in this section:

20           (a) "Health care plan" means a policy, contract, certificate or  
21 agreement offered or issued to provide, deliver, arrange for, pay for  
22 or reimburse any of the costs of health care services.

23           (b) "Health insurance exchange" means a program that provides  
24 information concerning health care plans, including, without  
25 limitation, information concerning costs, benefits, availability of and  
26 eligibility for health care plans.

27       **Sec. 2.** The Legislative Committee on Health Care shall  
28 provide to the Legislature as a result of its consideration of any of  
29 the topics listed in section 1 of this act any recommendations for  
30 legislation.
