SUMMARY—Makes a supplemental appropriation to the Division of Forestry of the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources for unanticipated shortfalls in Fiscal Year 2008-2009 for costs associated with the closure of the Tonopah Conservation Camp. (BDR S-1261)

AN ACT making a supplemental appropriation to the Division of Forestry of the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources for unanticipated shortfalls in Fiscal Year 2008-2009 for costs associated with the closure of the Tonopah Conservation Camp; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State
- 2 General Fund to the Division of Forestry of the State Department of
- 3 Conservation and Natural Resources the sum of \$38,763 for
- 4 unanticipated shortfalls in Fiscal Year 2008-2009 for costs
- 5 associated with the closure of the Tonopah Conservation Camp.
- 6 This appropriation is supplemental to that made by section 26 of
- 7 chapter 350, Statutes of Nevada 2007, at page 1699.
- 8 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
