AN ACT relating to taxicabs; requiring the Taxicab Authority to determine the geographical area of operation of any additional taxicabs that are temporarily allocated; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 **Section 1** of this bill requires the Taxicab Authority to determine the
2 geographical area of operation of any additional taxicabs that are temporarily
3 allocated. (NRS 706.88245)

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 706.88245 is hereby amended to read as
2 follows:

3 706.88245 1. In determining whether circumstances require a
4 temporary increase in the number of taxicabs allocated pursuant to
5 NRS 706.8824, the Taxicab Authority shall consider the interests,
6 welfare, convenience, necessity and well-being of the customers of
7 taxicabs.

8 2. Whenever circumstances require a temporary increase in the
9 number of taxicabs allocated pursuant to NRS 706.8824, the
10 Taxicab Authority shall allocate the temporary increase equally

1 among the certificate holders in the area to be affected by the
2 allocation.

3 3. The Taxicab Authority shall determine:

4 (a) The number of additional taxicabs to be allocated;

5 (b) The hours of operation of the additional taxicabs; ~~and~~

6 (c) The duration of the temporary allocation ~~H; and~~

7 (d) *The geographical area from which service is offered or*
8 *provided by the additional taxicabs.*

9 4. The Taxicab Authority may adopt regulations governing
10 temporary increases in the allocation of taxicabs pursuant to this
11 section.

12 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
