

SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 38—  
SENATOR HORSFORD

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Read and Adopted

SUMMARY—Directs the Legislative Commission to conduct an interim study concerning community redevelopment in Nevada. (BDR R-1338)

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SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION—Directing the Legislative Commission to conduct an interim study concerning community redevelopment in Nevada.

1     RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, THE  
2 ASSEMBLY CONCURRING, That the Legislative Commission is  
3 hereby directed to appoint a committee, composed of three members  
4 of the Senate and three members of the Assembly, to conduct an  
5 interim study concerning community redevelopment in Nevada; and  
6 be it further

7     RESOLVED, That the study must include, without limitation, an  
8 examination of:

9       1. The current scope and functioning of redevelopment  
10 agencies and tourism improvement districts including the manner in  
11 which both redevelopment agencies and tourism improvement  
12 districts are currently functioning in the communities throughout  
13 this State and alternatives for broadening the role of redevelopment  
14 agencies to ensure that the needs of all local governments are met in  
15 a timely and efficient manner;

16       2. The interaction between redevelopment agencies and the  
17 communities they serve, including the manner in which the goals  
18 and accomplishments of these agencies are communicated to the  
19 community and the manner in which decisions that affect the  
20 community are made;

21       3. The manner in which the effectiveness of redevelopment  
22 agencies is evaluated and the participation of local communities in  
23 this evaluation process; and

1       4. The future role of redevelopment agencies in communities;  
2 and be it further

3       RESOLVED, That any recommended legislation proposed by the  
4 committee must be approved by a majority of the members of the  
5 Senate and a majority of the members of the Assembly appointed to  
6 the committee; and be it further

7       RESOLVED, That the Legislative Commission shall submit a  
8 report of the results of the study and any recommendations for  
9 legislation to the 76th Session of the Nevada Legislature.
