Assembly Bill 335 (2nd Reprint): Makes various changes relating to nuisances and criminal gangs. (BDR 3-85)

We will concur with this amendment.

The second bill is Assembly Bill 361 (2nd Reprint).

Assembly Bill 361 (2nd Reprint): Makes changes relating to common-interest communities. (BDR 10-940)

We will allow Assemblyman McArthur some time to review the amendment, so we will not take any action today.

The third bill is Assembly Bill 496 (2nd Reprint).

Assembly Bill 496 (2nd Reprint): Revises provisions governing judicial discipline. (BDR 1-1110)

We will concur with this amendment.

The fourth bill is <u>Assembly Bill 500 (3rd Reprint)</u>.

Assembly Bill 500 (3rd Reprint): Revises provisions relating to domestic relations. (BDR 11-1156)

We will concur with this amendment.

The penultimate bill is Assembly Bill 88 (3rd Reprint).

Assembly Bill 88 (3rd Reprint): Makes various changes relating to child pornography. (BDR 15-267)

We will not concur with the amendment. I will appoint Assemblyman Horne to chair the conference committee, and Assemblyman Carpenter and I will also sit on it.
