Senate Bill 411 (1st Reprint): Revises provisions governing the issuance of hunting, fishing and trapping licenses. (BDR 45-1177)

Ms. Ruedy has provided each of you with a copy of the report and recommendation agreed upon by the Subcommittee. There is also a proposed amendment attached ([Exhibit A](#)). Mr. Bobzien, Subcommittee chair, will present the report.

Assemblyman Bobzien:

The primary concern addressed by the Subcommittee in the proposed amendment was brought forward by Mr. Ira Hansen regarding the intentional interference with lawful traps. The proposed amendment to *Nevada Revised Statutes* (NRS) 503.454 would make the language similar to that found in NRS 503.015, which prohibits a person from "intentionally interfering with another person who is lawfully hunting or trapping." The Subcommittee recommends to the Committee as a whole the consideration of a motion to amend and do pass as amended S.B. 411 (R1).
