S.J.R. 2*	Proposes to amend the Nevada Constitution to revise provisions relating to the selection of justices and judges. (BDR C-177)
S.B. 160	Makes various changes to comport with the constitutional doctrines of separation of powers and legislative privilege and immunity. (BDR 3-1164)
