S.B. 342 Expands the relatives who receive preference when a child is placed in the custody of a person other than the parent of the child by a court, an agency which provides child welfare services or other person.

S.B. 343 (R1) Makes various changes concerning the application for and provision of certain treatment or services to a person involved in the child welfare system. (BDR 38-477)

S.B. 344

Authorizes the Director of the Department of Health and Human Services to create an interagency committee to evaluate the child welfare system. (BDR 38-475)

S.C.R. 4 (R1) Urges certain agencies which provide child welfare services to develop a standardized practice model and to address certain issues related to child and family services. (BDR R-476)
