A.B. 321	Temporarily requires the diversion of a portion of the proceeds of an optional sales and use tax imposed in certain counties to the State to mitigate reductions in state revenue resulting from the current economic downturn. (BDR S-646)
A.B. 386	Proposes to exempt sales to senior citizens of hearing aids, hearing aid accessories and ophthalmic or ocular devices or appliances from sales and use taxes and analogous taxes. (BDR 32-525)

Revises various provisions governing sales and use taxes to ensure A.B. 403 continued compliance with the Streamlined Sales and Use Tax Agreement. (BDR 32-752)
