S.B. 415	Establishes for the next biennium the maximum amount to be paid to the Public Employees' Benefits Program for group insurance for certain active and retired public officers and employees. (BDR S-1191)

A.B. 536	Requires the transfer of a certain sum of money from the Amateur Boxing Program Reserve of the Nevada Athletic Commission to the State General Fund. (BDR S-1213)
