<u>A.B. 47</u> (R1)	Revises provisions relating to specialty courts. (BDR 14-409)
<u>A.B. 116</u> (R1)	Revises provisions concerning compensation for victims of crime. (BDR 16-1)
A.B. 168 (R1)	Revises sentencing provisions relating to certain convicted persons who provide substantial assistance in the investigation or prosecution of other offenses. (BDR 40-653)
A.B. 209 (R1)	Revises provisions governing the attendance of certain offenders at meetings of panels of victims of crimes relating to driving under the influence. (BDR 43-872)
A.B. 230 (R1)	Revises the provisions governing the carrying of a concealed firearm. (BDR 15-200)
