Opening remarks.

A.B. 41 (R1)	Makes various changes to voter registration and voting procedures for certain members of the Armed Forces of the United States and certain members of their families, and certain other voters who reside outside the United States. (BDR 24-324)
<u>A.B. 231</u> (R1)	Exempts certain veterans from the requirement to pay any fee established for registration as an uncompensated lobbyist. (BDR 17-998)
A.B. 79 (R1)	Revises provisions concerning city elections. (BDR 24-486)
