[S.B. 109](#) Deletes the provisions that place each state grazing board within the State Department of Agriculture. (BDR 50-495)

[S.B. 110](#) Authorizes the State Quarantine Officer to adopt regulations specifying a schedule of administrative fines for certain violations relating to noxious weeds. (BDR 49-500)

[S.C.R. 3](#) Expresses disapproval of certain civil actions brought and maintained against the livestock industry and the Bureau of Land Management in Nevada. (BDR R-496)
