[S.B. 38](#) Revises the period of validity of certificates to apply restricted-use pesticides. (BDR 49-355)

[S.B. 39](#) Eliminates the requirement that the State Department of Agriculture provide annual proposed programs for the control of invasive species and certain endemic pests and weeds to counties. (BDR 50-356)

[S.B. 108](#) Requires the placement of solid markers on lode mining claims. (BDR 46-498)

[S.B. 109](#) Deletes the provisions that place each state grazing board within the State Department of Agriculture. (BDR 50-495)
