<u>S.B. 110</u>	Authorizes the State Quarantine Officer to adopt regulations specifying a schedule of administrative fines for certain violations relating to noxious weeds. (BDR 49-500)
S.B. 204	Revises provisions governing notice of an application for a permit to appropriate water. (BDR 48-1086)
<u>S.J.R. 2</u>	Urges Congress to take certain actions concerning wilderness areas and wilderness study areas. (BDR R-604)
<u>S.J.R. 7</u>	Expresses opposition to congressional enactment of the National Landscape Conservation System. (BDR R-983)
S.J.R. 8	Urges Congress to preserve the traditional power of the states over land and water use. (BDR R-984)
