[S.B. 110](#)      Authorizes the State Quarantine Officer to adopt regulations specifying a schedule of administrative fines for certain violations relating to noxious weeds. (BDR 49-500)

[S.B. 132](#)      Revises provisions governing the treatment of animals. (BDR 50-369)

[S.B. 133](#)      Prohibits a person from possessing an animal for certain purposes. (BDR 50-26)

[S.B. 137](#)      Provides for the placement of recycling containers in certain locations. (BDR 40-741)

[S.B. 219](#)      Revises provisions governing assessments on real property located within a weed control district. (BDR 49-499)
