<u>S.B. 2</u>	Makes an appropriation to the State Distributive School Account to ensure that the amount of money expended per pupil meets or exceeds the national average. (BDR S-4)
S.B. 272	Makes various changes concerning the state budget process. (BDR 31-780)
<u>S.B. 316</u>	Requires school districts, charter schools and university schools for profoundly gifted pupils to expend a certain percentage of money on direct classroom expenditures. (BDR 34-823)
<u>S.B. 372</u>	Revises provisions governing the use of money received by school districts and charter schools from the State Supplemental School Support Fund. (BDR 34-970)
