FIRST REVISED AGENDA

[S.B. 309](#) Authorizes a person to remove from his or her property an animal for which he or she has, by contract, provided care and shelter under certain circumstances. (BDR 50-703)

WORK SESSION

[S.B. 120](#) Revises provisions governing the Committee on High-Level Radioactive Waste. (BDR 40-248)

[S.J.R. 3](#) Urges Congress to enact legislation to require the Secretary of the Interior to convey ownership of certain land to the State of Nevada to help fund education. (BDR R-90)

[S.J.R. 4](#) Urges Congress to take certain actions concerning federal public lands in Nevada. (BDR R-212)

[S.J.R. 8](#) Urges the Federal Government and certain other governmental entities to expedite and streamline the requirements for conducting mining operations in this State. (BDR R-1035)
