SUMMARY—Revises provisions governing exemptions from the requirements for licensure of driving schools. (BDR 43-600)

AN ACT relating to the training of drivers; revising requirements that an automobile drivers’ education course offered by a public school or educational institution must meet for the school or institution to be exempted from the requirements for licensure as a driving school; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel’s Digest:**

1 Under existing law, public schools and educational institutions in which driving  
2 instruction is part of the curriculum are exempted from laws requiring licensure of  
3 driver training schools and instructors for such schools. (NRS 483.770) This bill  
4 revises that exemption to require that, to qualify for the exemption, the public  
5 school or educational institution: (1) must allow a student to apply the credit earned  
6 for an automobile drivers’ education course to those credits required for graduation;  
7 and (2) must not charge the student any fee for the course other than a laboratory  
8 fee that may only cover the actual costs of providing the laboratory portion of the  
9 course.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 483.770 is hereby amended to read as follows:  
2 483.770 The provisions of NRS 483.700 to 483.780, inclusive,  
3 do not apply to:  
4 1. Public schools or educational institutions in which driving  
5 instruction is part of the curriculum ~~is~~, *provided that:*



- 1        *(a) A pupil who completes an automobile drivers' education*  
2 *course is allowed to apply the credit received for the course to the*  
3 *total number of credits required for graduation from high school;*  
4 *and*  
5        *(b) The automobile drivers' education course is offered at no*  
6 *charge other than the laboratory fee authorized pursuant to*  
7 *NRS 389.100.*  
8        2. Automobile dealers or their salespersons giving instruction  
9 without charge to purchasers of motor vehicles.  
10        3. Employers giving instruction to their employees.  
11        **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2011.
