SUMMARY—Revises provisions relating to design-build contracts entered into by the Department of Transportation.
(BDR 35-851)

AN ACT relating to transportation; revising provisions governing the authority of the Department of Transportation to enter into contracts with design-build teams; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

- 1 Under existing law, the Department of Transportation is authorized, under
2 certain circumstances, to enter into one or more contracts known as design-build
3 contracts with teams that consist of at least one general contractor and an architect
4 or professional engineer for the design and construction of projects estimated to
5 cost more than \$20 million. Once each fiscal year, the Department is authorized to
6 enter into a design-build contract for a project estimated to cost between \$5 million
7 and \$20 million. (NRS 408.388) This bill: (1) removes the limitation on the number
8 of smaller projects for which the Department is authorized to enter into design-
9 build contracts in a fiscal year; and (2) decreases to \$1 million the threshold at
10 which the Department is authorized to enter into a design-build contract for a
11 project.
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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 408.388 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 build team for the design and construction of a project if the

7 **1. The** estimated cost of the project exceeds ~~[\$20,000,000;]~~

9 ~~(b)~~ **2.** Contracting with a design-build team will enable the
10 Department to:

11 ~~(1)~~ **(a)** Design and construct the project at a cost that is
12 significantly lower than the cost that the Department would incur to
13 design and construct the project using a different method;

14 ~~(2)~~ **(b)** Design and construct the project in a shorter time
15 than would be required to complete the project using a different
16 method, if exigent circumstances require that the project be
17 designed and constructed within a short time; or

18 ~~(3)~~ **(c)** Ensure that the design and construction of the
19 project is properly coordinated, if the project is unique, highly
20 technical and complex in nature.

21 ~~12. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 1, the
22 Department may, once in each fiscal year, contract with a design-
23 build team for the design and construction of a project the estimated
24 cost of which is at least \$5,000,000 but less than \$20,000,000 if the
25 Department makes the determinations otherwise required pursuant
26 to paragraph (b) of subsection 1.]~~
