SUMMARY—Revises provisions governing contracts for public works. (BDR 28-582)

FISCAL NOTE: Effect on Local Government: May have Fiscal Impact.
Effect on the State: Yes.

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EXPLANATION – Matter in ***bolded italics*** is new; matter between brackets [omitted material] is material to be omitted.

AN ACT relating to public works; requiring a public body to use a standard form construction contract that is endorsed by national associations representing industry professionals for a public work; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Under existing law, a public body is required to include certain provisions in a contract for a public work. (NRS 338.150, 338.153, 338.155) This bill requires a public body to use a standard form construction contract which has been endorsed by national associations representing industry professionals for each contract for a public work.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 338 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3 ***A contract for a public work must be a standard form
4 construction contract which includes terms, conditions and
5 agreements endorsed by at least one national association that
6 primarily represents the interests of public owners and at least one
7 national association that primarily represents the interests of
8 private contractors, provided that:***



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- 1 *1. A public body shall make any modifications necessary to*
- 2 *conform with the laws and regulations of this State;*
- 3 *2. A public body may make any reasonably necessary*
- 4 *modifications for project-specific considerations; and*
- 5 *3. The terms, conditions and agreements of a contract*
- 6 *between a subcontractor and a contractor must be consistent with*
- 7 *the terms, conditions and agreements of the contract for a public*
- 8 *work entered into between the contractor and a public body*
- 9 *pursuant to this section.*

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
