AN ACT relating to juries; repealing the prospective expiration of the exemption from jury service of any police officer; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

- 1 Under existing law, police officers are exempt from service as grand or trial
2 jurors, but this provision is only effective through June 30, 2011. (NRS 6.020) This
3 bill repeals the prospective expiration of the exemption from jury service of any
4 police officer. (Section 3, chapter 136, Statutes of Nevada 2007, p. 417)

SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** Section 3 of chapter 136, Statutes of Nevada 2007,
2 at page 417, is hereby amended to read as follows:

7 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2011.
