AN ACT relating to civil actions; requiring a person who owns or controls the premises on which an injury or death allegedly occurred to produce certain evidence under certain circumstances; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel’s Digest:

1 This bill requires a person who owns or controls the premises on which an
2 injury or death allegedly occurred to produce copies of any visual evidence
3 pertaining to a claim for personal injury or death when such visual evidence is
4 requested by a claimant or a claimant’s attorney. The provisions of this bill do not
5 apply if the claimant has already commenced a civil action against the person who
6 owns or controls such premises.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 41 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:
3 *1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2, any person*
4 *against whom a claim is asserted for compensation or damages for*
5 *personal injury or death that allegedly occurred on any premises*



1 *under the person's ownership or control shall, upon request,*
2 *provide to the claimant or any attorney representing the claimant*
3 *copies of any visual evidence pertaining to the claim. The claimant*
4 *or the claimant's attorney shall reimburse the person for the*
5 *reasonable costs of providing such copies of visual evidence.*
6 2. *This section does not apply if the claimant has commenced*
7 *a civil action against the person who owns or controls the*
8 *premises on which the personal injury or death allegedly occurred.*
9 3. *As used in this section, "visual evidence" means any still*
10 *or recorded information. The term includes, without limitation,*
11 *any photograph, film, video recording or other visual image.*
