

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 332—ASSEMBLYMEN CONKLIN,  
KIRKPATRICK; AND SMITH

MARCH 21, 2011

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Referred to Committee on Government Affairs

SUMMARY—Makes various changes relating to the Economic Forum. (BDR 31-307)

FISCAL NOTE: Effect on Local Government: No.

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EXPLANATION – Matter in ***bolded italics*** is new; matter between brackets **[omitted material]** is material to be omitted.

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AN ACT relating to state financial administration; amending certain reporting requirements of the Economic Forum; requiring the Economic Forum to hold additional meetings; authorizing the Economic Forum to request certain information and testimony; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

Under existing law, the Economic Forum, a panel of economic and financial experts appointed by the Governor, the Majority Floor Leader of the Senate and the Speaker of the Assembly, provides revenue estimates and projections to the Governor and the Legislature. (NRS 353.226, 353.228) This bill makes a number of changes to the operations of the Economic Forum. **Section 2** of this bill requires certain reports of the Economic Forum that currently must be made, respectively, on or before December 1 before each regular session of the Legislature and on or before May 1 of the following year to instead be made on or before December 3 of each even-numbered year and May 1 of each odd-numbered year. **Section 2** also requires the Economic Forum to hold additional meetings, on or before June 10 of each even-numbered year and December 10 of each odd-numbered year, to consider current economic indicators and to update the status of actual State General Fund revenue accordingly, as compared to the most recent revenue estimates made by the Economic Forum. The Economic Forum then must present the updated information to the Interim Finance Committee and must make the information available to the public on the website of the Legislature. Finally, **section 2** authorizes the Economic Forum to request testimony and information from any state agency, which then must provide the testimony or information.

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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1      **Section 1.** (Deleted by amendment.)

2      **Sec. 2.** NRS 353.228 is hereby amended to read as follows:

3            353.228 1. The Economic Forum impaneled pursuant to NRS  
4            353.226 shall:

5            (a) Make such projections for economic indicators as it deems  
6            necessary to ensure that an accurate estimate is produced pursuant to  
7            paragraph (b);

8            (b) Provide an accurate estimate of the revenue that will be  
9            collected by the State for general, unrestricted uses, and not for  
10            special purposes, during the biennium that begins on July 1 of the  
11            year following the date on which the Economic Forum was  
12            empaneled;

13            (c) Request such technical assistance as the Economic Forum  
14            deems necessary from the Technical Advisory Committee created  
15            by NRS 353.229;

16            (d) On or before December **[H]** 3 of **[the] each even-numbered**  
17            year, **[in which the Economic Forum was empaneled.]** prepare a  
18            written report of its projections of economic indicators and estimate  
19            of future state revenue required by paragraphs (a) and (b) and  
20            present the report to the Governor and the Legislature; **[and]**

21            (e) On or before May 1 of **[the] each odd-numbered** year,  
22            **[following the year in which the Economic Forum was empaneled.]**  
23            prepare a written report confirming or revising the projections of  
24            economic indicators and estimate of future state revenue contained  
25            in the report prepared pursuant to paragraph (d) and present the  
26            report to the Governor and the Legislature **[H]; and**

27            **(f) Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2, on or before**  
28            **June 10 of each even-numbered year and December 10 of each**  
29            **odd-numbered year, hold a meeting to consider current economic**  
30            **indicators, including, without limitation, employment,**  
31            **unemployment, personal income and any other indicators deemed**  
32            **appropriate by the Economic Forum. Based on current economic**  
33            **indicators, the Economic Forum shall update the status of actual**  
34            **State General Fund revenue compared to the most recent forecast**  
35            **of the Economic Forum. The provisions of this paragraph are not**  
36            **intended to authorize the Economic Forum to make additional**  
37            **forecasts pursuant to paragraph (b). At the next appropriate**  
38            **meeting of the Interim Finance Committee, the Chair of the**  
39            **Economic Forum or a member of the staff of the Economic**  
40            **Forum shall present to the Interim Finance Committee such**  
41            **matters considered at the meeting of the Economic Forum held**  
42            **pursuant to this paragraph, as the Economic Forum determines**



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1      appropriate. Any such information presented to the Interim  
2      Finance Committee must be made available on the Internet  
3      website of the Legislature.

4      2. If the deadline for preparing a report or holding a meeting  
5      as required in subsection 1 falls on a Saturday, Sunday or legal  
6      holiday, the deadline is extended to the second business day  
7      following the deadline.

8      3. The Economic Forum may make preliminary projections of  
9      economic indicators and estimates of future state revenue at any  
10     time. Any such projections and estimates must be made available to  
11     the various agencies of the State through the Chief.

12     **[§]** 4. The Economic Forum may request information directly  
13     from any state agency **[H]**, including, without limitation, the  
14     **Nevada System of Higher Education**. A state agency, including,  
15     without limitation, the **Nevada System of Higher Education**, that  
16     receives a reasonable request for information from the Economic  
17     Forum shall comply with the request as soon as is reasonably  
18     practicable after receiving the request.

19     **[¶]** 5. **The Economic Forum may request direct testimony**  
20     **from any state agency, including, without limitation, the Nevada**  
21     **System of Higher Education, at a meeting of the Economic Forum**  
22     **or the Technical Advisory Committee. The head, or a designee**  
23     **thereof, of a state agency, including, without limitation, the**  
24     **Nevada System of Higher Education, who receives a reasonable**  
25     **request for direct testimony at a meeting of the Economic Forum**  
26     **or the Technical Advisory Committee shall appear at the meeting**  
27     **and shall comply with the request.**

28     6. To carry out its duties pursuant to this section, the Economic  
29     Forum may consider any information received from the Technical  
30     Advisory Committee and any other information received from  
31     independent sources.

32     **[§]** 7. Copies of the projections and estimates made pursuant  
33     to this section must be made available to the public by the Director  
34     of the Legislative Counsel Bureau for the cost of reproducing the  
35     material.

36     **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2011.
