

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 358—ASSEMBLYMAN BOBZIEN

SUMMARY—Revises provisions governing certain manufactured buildings. (BDR 43-1069)

AN ACT relating to manufactured buildings; requiring the Administrator of the Manufactured Housing Division of the Department of Business and Industry to adopt regulations prescribing certain safety standards with respect to portable buildings; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 Existing law authorizes the Administrator of the Manufactured Housing
2 Division of the Department of Business and Industry to adopt regulations with
3 respect to the construction, assembly, installation and use of certain structures.
4 (NRS 489.231, 489.241-489.261) **Section 3** of this bill requires the Administrator
5 to adopt regulations prescribing safety standards for the construction,
6 transportation, installation, inspection, maintenance, repair and use of a portable
7 building. A person who violates a regulation adopted by the Administrator pursuant
8 to existing law or **section 3** is subject to an administrative fine and a civil penalty.
9 (NRS 489.381, 489.421, 489.811)

10 **Section 5** of this bill exempts a portable building and a single-wide commercial
11 coach not for public use from regulation as a commercial coach.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 489 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
2 thereto the provisions set forth as sections 2 and 3 of this act.

3 **Sec. 2. “Portable building” means a structure which:**

4 **1. Is at ground level, has no axles and rests on the surface of
5 the ground;**

- 1 2. *Is for nonresidential use;*
2 3. *Is not a fixture or improvement to real property;*
3 4. *Is designed to be used without a permanent foundation;*
4 **and**
5 5. *Contains an electrical system with a component that allows
6 for the quick connection or disconnection of the electrical system
7 to a source of electricity.*

8 Sec. 3. *The Administrator shall adopt regulations prescribing
9 safety standards for:*

- 10 1. *The construction, transportation, installation and use of a
11 portable building;*
12 2. *The inspection of any plumbing, heating, cooling, fuel
13 burning or electrical system contained in a portable building; and*
14 3. *The maintenance and repair of a portable building.*

15 Sec. 4. NRS 489.031 is hereby amended to read as follows:

16 489.031 As used in this chapter, unless the context otherwise
17 requires, the words and terms defined in NRS 489.036 to 489.155,
18 inclusive, ***and section 2 of this act*** have the meanings ascribed to
19 them in those sections.

20 Sec. 5. NRS 489.062 is hereby amended to read as follows:

21 489.062 “Commercial coach” means a structure without
22 motive power which is designed and equipped for human occupancy
23 for industrial, professional or commercial purposes. The term does
24 not include a recreational park trailer **H**, ***portable building or***
25 ***single-wide commercial coach not for public use.***
