

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 370—ASSEMBLYMEN HANSEN;

SUMMARY—Establishes requirements for the indication of a person's gender on documents submitted to governmental agencies. (BDR 19-608)

AN ACT relating to governmental administration; establishing requirements for the indication of a person's gender on documents submitted to an agency of the State or a local government; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 This bill provides that if a person's gender is required to be indicated on a
2 document submitted to an agency of the State or a local government, the gender
3 indicated on the document must be the gender shown on the person's birth
4 certificate unless the person: (1) has undergone surgery for gender reassignment;
5 and (2) submits a declaration from a physician licensed in this State confirming that
6 the person has undergone such surgery.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 239B of NRS is hereby amended by adding
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3 *1. If the gender of a person is required to be indicated on a*
4 *document that is recorded, filed or otherwise submitted to a*
5 *governmental agency, the gender indicated on the document must*
6 *be the gender shown on the person's birth certificate unless the*
7 *person:*

8 *(a) Has undergone surgery for gender reassignment; and*



1 ***(b) Submits a declaration from a licensed physician***
2 ***confirming that the person has undergone such surgery.***

3 ***2. Any declaration or other related information submitted***
4 ***pursuant to paragraph (b) of subsection 1 is confidential and must***
5 ***not be disclosed.***

6 ***3. As used in this section, “governmental agency” means an***
7 ***officer, board, commission, department, division, bureau, district***
8 ***or any other unit of government of the State or a local***
9 ***government.***
