

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 408—ASSEMBLYMEN  
SEGERBLOM AND FLORES

MARCH 21, 2011

Referred to Committee on Judiciary

SUMMARY—Restricts the use of restraints on pregnant females who are in confinement. (BDR 16-117)

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EXPLANATION – Matter in *bolded italics* is new; matter between brackets [omitted-material] is material to be omitted.

AN ACT relating to the administration of justice; restricting the use of restraints on pregnant females who are in confinement; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel’s Digest:**

1 **Sections 1 and 2** of this bill prohibit the use of restraints on a prisoner who is  
2 in labor, delivering a baby or recuperating from delivery unless the prisoner  
3 presents a risk of harm or flight. If restraints are used on a prisoner who is in labor,  
4 delivering a baby or recuperating from delivery, the restraints used must be the  
5 least restrictive restraints which are necessary to ensure safety and security.

6 **Sections 3 and 4** of this bill provide for the same prohibitions and limitations  
7 on the use of restraints on pregnant children confined in a state, local or private  
8 facility or institution for the detention of children.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 209 of NRS is hereby amended by adding  
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3 *1. No restraints of any kind may be used on an offender who*  
4 *is in labor, delivering her baby or recuperating from delivery*  
5 *unless there are compelling reasons to believe that the offender*  
6 *presents:*

7 (a) *A serious and immediate threat of harm to herself, staff or*  
8 *others; or*



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1       ***(b) A substantial flight risk and cannot be reasonably confined***  
2 ***by other means.***

3       ***2. If an offender who is in labor, delivering her baby or***  
4 ***recuperating from delivery is restrained, only the least restrictive***  
5 ***restraints which are necessary to ensure safety and security may***  
6 ***be used.***

7       **Sec. 2.** Chapter 211 of NRS is hereby amended by adding  
8 thereto a new section to read as follows:

9       ***1. No restraints of any kind may be used on a prisoner who***  
10 ***is in labor, delivering her baby or recuperating from delivery***  
11 ***unless there are compelling reasons to believe that the prisoner***  
12 ***presents:***

13       ***(a) A serious and immediate threat of harm to herself, staff or***  
14 ***others; or***

15       ***(b) A substantial flight risk and cannot be reasonably confined***  
16 ***by other means.***

17       ***2. If a prisoner who is in labor, delivering her baby or***  
18 ***recuperating from delivery is restrained, only the least restrictive***  
19 ***restraints which are necessary to ensure safety and security may***  
20 ***be used.***

21       **Sec. 3.** Chapter 62B of NRS is hereby amended by adding  
22 thereto a new section to read as follows:

23       ***1. No restraints of any kind may be used on a child who is in***  
24 ***labor, delivering her baby or recuperating from delivery unless***  
25 ***there are compelling reasons to believe that the child presents:***

26       ***(a) A serious and immediate threat of harm to herself, staff or***  
27 ***others; or***

28       ***(b) A substantial flight risk and cannot be reasonably confined***  
29 ***by other means.***

30       ***2. If a child who is in labor, delivering her baby or***  
31 ***recuperating from delivery is restrained, only the least restrictive***  
32 ***restraints which are necessary to ensure safety and security may***  
33 ***be used.***

34       **Sec. 4.** Chapter 63 of NRS is hereby amended by adding  
35 thereto a new section to read as follows:

36       ***1. No restraints of any kind may be used on a child who is in***  
37 ***labor, delivering her baby or recuperating from delivery unless***  
38 ***there are compelling reasons to believe that the child presents:***

39       ***(a) A serious and immediate threat of harm to herself, staff or***  
40 ***others; or***

41       ***(b) A substantial flight risk and cannot be reasonably confined***  
42 ***by other means.***
