AN ACT relating to civil actions; limiting the liability of certain independent contractors; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

1 Existing law limits the tort liability of state employees and certain independent  
2 contractors. (NRS 41.035) **Section 1** of this bill includes within the limitation of  
3 liability an independent contractor who has entered into a contract with a regional  
4 transportation commission to provide transportation services.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1      **Section 1.** NRS 41.0307 is hereby amended to read as follows:  
2      41.0307 As used in NRS 41.0305 to 41.039, inclusive:  
3      1. “Employee” includes an employee of a:  
4       (a) Part-time or full-time board, commission or similar body of  
5       the State or a political subdivision of the State which is created by  
6       law.  
7       (b) Charter school.  
8       (c) University school for profoundly gifted pupils described in  
9       chapter 392A of NRS.  
10      2. “Employment” includes any services performed by an  
11      immune contractor.

1       3. “Immune contractor” means any natural person, professional  
2 corporation or professional association which:

3           (a) Is an independent contractor with the State pursuant to NRS  
4 333.700 [H] and

5           **[((b)-Contracts] contracts** to provide [medical] services for the  
6 Department of Corrections.

7           **(b) Is an independent contractor with a regional transportation**  
8 **commission and contracts to provide transportation services.**

9      → As used in this subsection, “professional corporation” and  
10 “professional association” have the meanings ascribed to them in  
11 NRS 89.020.

12       4. “Public officer” or “officer” includes:

13           (a) A member of a part-time or full-time board, commission or  
14 similar body of the State or a political subdivision of the State which  
15 is created by law.

16           (b) A public defender and any deputy or assistant attorney of a  
17 public defender or an attorney appointed to defend a person for a limited  
18 duration with limited jurisdiction.

19           (c) A district attorney and any deputy or assistant district  
20 attorney or an attorney appointed to prosecute a person for a limited  
21 duration with limited jurisdiction.

22       **Sec. 2.** The amendatory provisions of this act apply to a cause  
23 of action that accrues on or after July 1, 2011.

24       **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2011.
